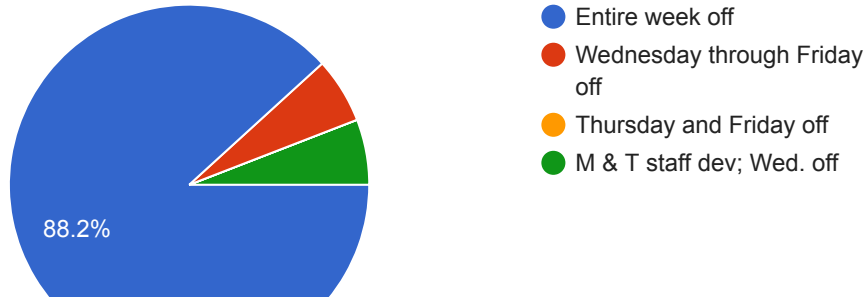

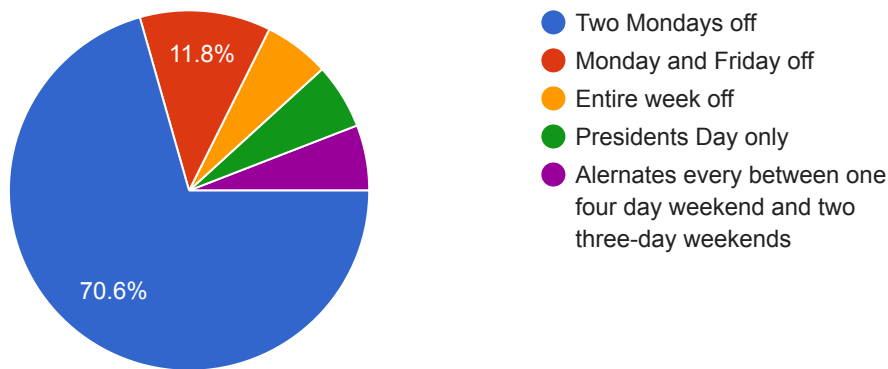

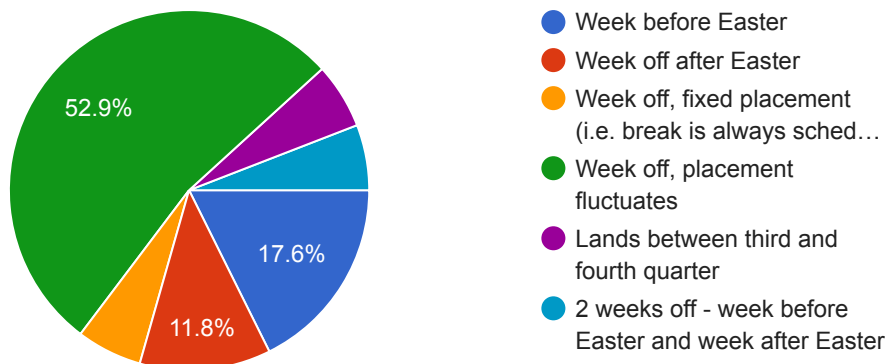
Please select the option that best describes your February holiday structure:

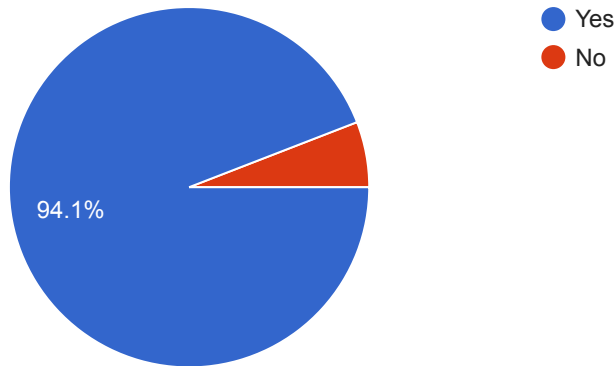

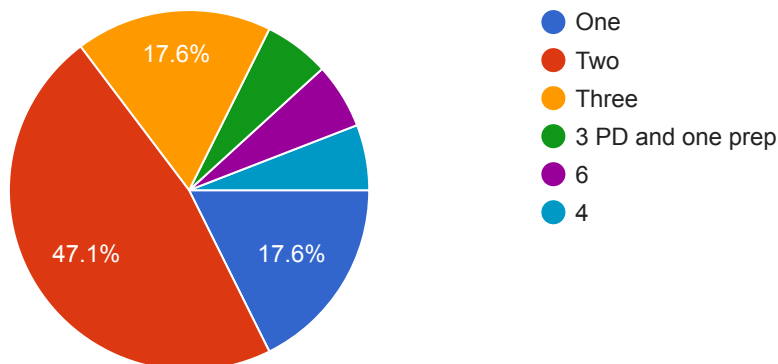

How many NON-STUDENT days of professional development does your calendar provide? (do not include pre-service days before students start school)

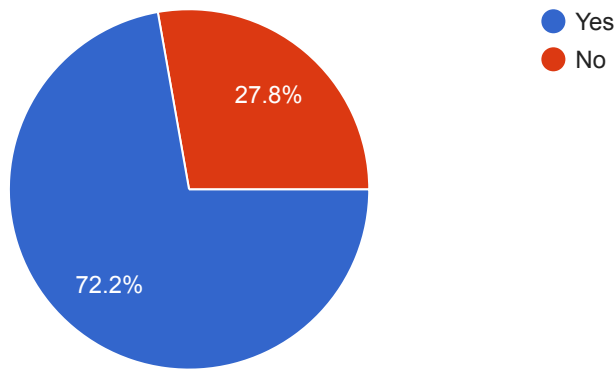

Have you undergone a calendar structure change (starting/ending earlier or later) within the last five years?

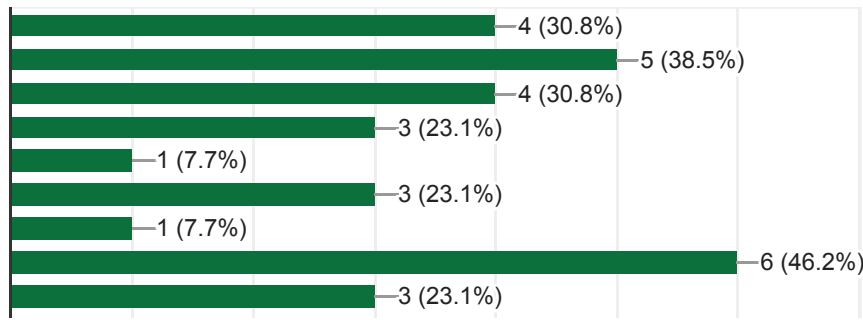

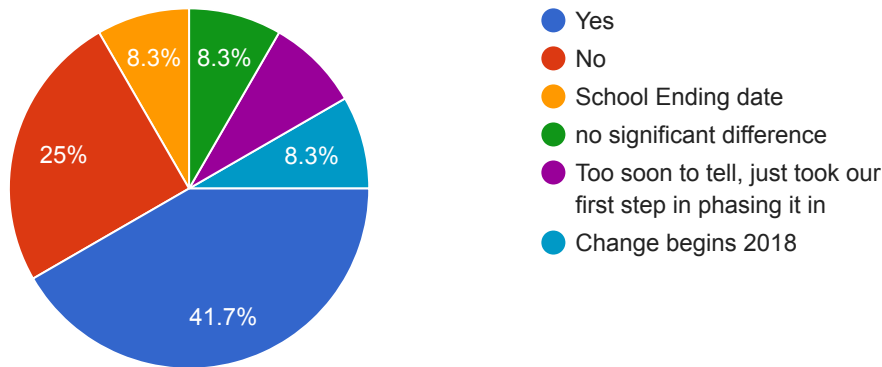
